

Banner – University Family Care Plan selected for Medicaid contract

Insurer one of seven to help provide integrated health care to Arizona’s Medicaid members

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PHOENIX (March 7, 2018) – Banner -- University Family Care, part of Banner -- University Health Plans, has been selected to help serve 1.5 million Medicaid members in Arizona.

The contract, which will align all physical and behavioral health services under a single plan, was announced by the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS) earlier this week.

Banner -- University Family Care was one of seven integrated managed care organizations selected to provide care as part of the \$50 billion AHCCCS Complete Care contract.

“We are honored to have been selected to continue to serve AHCCCS members in central and southern Arizona,” said Kathy Oestreich, vice president and CEO of Banner Health – University of Arizona Health Plans. “The integrated care model, which is the blending of physical and behavioral health, allows innovation and reduces fragmentation to improve health outcomes. This process will make access to health care easier.”

Banner – University Family Care will coordinate physical and behavioral health services for the 10 counties, including Maricopa and Pima counties.

The AHCCCS Complete Care contract goes into effect Oct. 1, 2018.
